Every word that comes out of our mouths should exalt God; instead, let us speak in an atmosphere of love, kindness, and respect. Let us refrain from speaking in any way that does not glorify God. Second, bringing our thoughts into line with God's truth and principles helps us think righteously (Philippians 4: 4–8) with a refreshed and sound mind. Thirdly, it makes it possible for us to establish a righteous relationship with God, when we love people without pretending to be someone else, regardless of their race or ethnicity (1 John 4:7–12) (Matthew 22:39). Ultimately, as we believe in God, His strength enables us to act and behave morally (James 2: 14–24). The Lord will always use us to accomplish exploits similar to the stories of faith of the legends found in Hebrew 11 when our trust remains unwavering in Him. In the name of Jesus Christ, may the Holy Spirit quicken our body, soul, and spirit and enable us to live righteously while we wait for Christ's return.

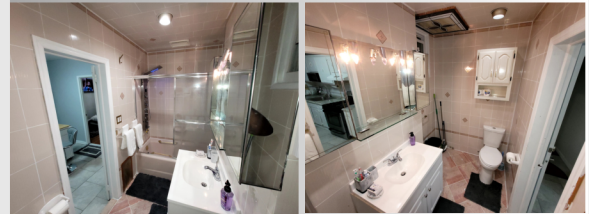
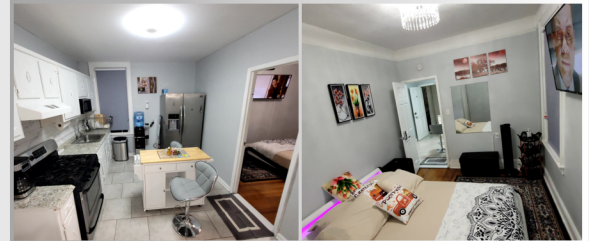
